CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, and the Respondents Crystal Phillips and Safety National Casualty Corporation (“Respondents”), and enter into this Consent Order.

JURISDICTION

1. John D. Doak is the Oklahoma Insurance Commissioner, having full power and authority to administer the provisions of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code, 59 O.S. §§1301-1340.
2. Respondent Crystal Phillips (“Phillips”) is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 199487.
3. Respondent Safety National Casualty Corporation (“Safety National”) is an admitted insurer authorized as a bail surety company in the State of Oklahoma holding certificate of authority number 15105.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. On or about April 12, 2010, an appearance bond was issued as follows:

Defendant: Kenneth R. Henry

Case Number: CF-2007-1468
City/County: Oklahoma County
Bondsman: Crystal Phillips
Surety: Safety National Casualty Corporation
Power Number: S5-1885525
Bond Amount: \$4,000.00

2. On or about October 26, 2010, the defendant failed to appear, and the bond was declared forfeited. An Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued by the Oklahoma County District Court on November 17, 2010 and in the case. Both Respondents were mailed notice of the forfeiture within thirty (30) days after the date of the forfeiture.

3. Phillips received notice of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture on November 30, 2010. Safety National received notice of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture on November 22, 2010.

4. The ninety-first (91st) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Phillips was March 1, 2011. Respondents failed to return defendant to custody within ninety (90) days and failed to pay sums due on the forfeiture to the Oklahoma County Court Clerk on the ninety-first (91st) day.

5. The bond forfeiture was paid on March 2, 2011, the day following the ninety-first (91st) day.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondents have violated 59 O.S. § 1332(D) by failing to deposit cash or other valuable securities in the face amount of the bond with the Court Clerk within ninety-one (91) days from receipt or mailing of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture from the Payne County Court Clerk.

ORDER AND CONSENT

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and CONSENTED to by Respondents that they are each fined in the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for the above described violation of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the *Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to be Heard* issued and filed in this matter is hereby withdrawn.
