# **CONSENT ORDER**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, and American Century Life Insurance Company ("the Company") and state and agree as follows:

# **JURISDICTION**

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq. -- including 36 O.S. §§ 1654, 1655 and 1659.2
- 2. The Respondent is an insurer authorized to transact life, accident and health insurance business in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to Certificate of Authority Number 2558 (NAIC CoCode 97810).
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may impose a fine in the amount of \$200 per day -- up to a total of \$20,000 -- for violations of 36 O.S. §§ 1654 and/or 1655. See 36 O.S. § 1958.2.

# FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On or about July 15, 2011, a Conditional Order of Disciplinary Action was filed by the Insurance Commissioner in this matter relating to the Company's failure to submit that certain affiliate Agreement to Lease Property to the Insurance Commissioner for prior approval. A copy of this Agreement is attached to said Conditional Order of Disciplinary Action as Exhibit "A". This Agreement to Lease Property is between Respondent and its affiliate, The Stumpff Company. Such affiliate agreements must be submitted to the Commissioner for approval as required by 36 O.S. §§ 1654 and/or 1655.
- 2. The Company acknowledges it failed to make a proper Form D filing as to the above-described Agreement to Lease Property. The Company agrees that it will remedy this situation by (1) making a proper Form D filing of the subject agreement; and (2) paying a civil penalty in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), both within thirty (30) days of the date of the filing of this Consent Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §§ 619 and 1958.2, the Insurance Commissioner has the authority to assess a civil penalty and to otherwise act to ensure compliance with regulatory filings required by the Insurance Code.
- 2. The Insurance Commissioner and the Company acknowledge that this matter will be resolved as per the Findings of Fact set out above, which are incorporated herein by reference.

# **AGREED ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND AGREED by the parties that the Company will remedy this situation by (1) making a proper Form D filing of the subject Agreement to Lease Property; and (2) paying a civil penalty in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), both within thirty (30) days of the date of the filing of this Consent Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon payment of all fines and discharge of all duties as described above, this matter shall be resolved and completely concluded.
