FINAL ORDER OF REVOCATION

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his attorney, Julie Meaders, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
- 2. Jeromy Shane Jackson is a licensed resident producer holding license 102126. His address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department is P.O. Box 1233, Ada, Oklahoma 74820.
- 3. Shane Jackson Agency Inc. is a licensed resident insurance agency holding license 100101533. Its address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department is P.O. Box 1233, Ada, Oklahoma 74820. The owner and designated responsible licensed producer for Shane Jackson Agency Inc. is Jeromy Shane Jackson.

4. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Oklahoma Insurance Department was notified by the Oklahoma Department of Human Services that an Order Revoking Licenses was issued against Respondent on July 13, 2011 (Exhibit "A").
- 2. Pursuant to 56 O.S. §240.15, it was ordered that all of Respondent's occupational or professional licenses be revoked and that Respondent be refrained from engaging in any licensed activity for non-compliance with a court-ordered child support payment plan.
- 3. Failing to comply with an administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation is cause for the Insurance Commissioner to take administrative action against a licensee. 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A). An order of revocation and notice of right to be heard was issued against his insurance license and his agency's license and notice was sent to the mailing addresses of the individual and agency on file with the Department.
- 4. Both addresses on file with the Department are no longer valid addresses and the Revocation Order, sent certified mail, return receipt requested, was returned to the Department. Thereafter, as a courtesy, the Department again mailed the Order to an address given by the Department of Human Services.
- 5. Respondent thereafter requested a formal administrative hearing before an independent hearing examiner concerning the matter on September 1, 2011 and a hearing

was set for September 12, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. Petitioner appeared by counsel Julie Meaders. Respondent defaulted on his appearance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(13) by failing to comply with an administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation. A licensing board may charge the obligor a fee to cover the administrative costs incurred by the licensing board to administer the provisions of this section. 43 O.S. § 139.1(N).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner, subject to the following paragraph, that the Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(13). In accordance with 56 O.S. § 240.15(I) and 43 O.S. § 139.1(N), Respondents' producer licenses REMAIN REVOKED AND RESPONDENT IS ORDERED TO PAY HEARING COSTS of One Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$125.00).

ORDER REVOKING DEFENDANT'S LICENSES

Now on this <u>13th</u> day of <u>JULY</u>, <u>2011</u>, the above-entitled cause comes on before the Administrative Court for automatic suspension of the Defendant's licenses for noncompliance with a court-ordered payment plan, pursuant to Title 56 O.S. §240.15 et seq. and Title 47 O.S. §6-201.1. Department of Human Services appears through State's Attorney, Brenda Kimery.

Having examined the files and records in this case, having taken evidence and hearing statements of counsel, and being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds, and therefore orders, adjudges and decrees that:

- 1. This Administrative Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties to this proceeding.
- 2. On the 28^{th} day of OCTOBER, 2009, an Administrative Enforcement Order was entered herein.
- 3. The Defendant is not in full compliance with this Administrative Enforcement Order.
- 4. Any and all licenses, as defined by Title 43 O.S. § 139.1(A)(5) and Title 56 O.S. § 237.7, held by the Defendant are hereby revoked; and the Defendant shall refrain from engaging in any licensed activity.
- 5. The Defendant's driver's license is suspended and revoked until further order of this Court.
- 6. The Defendant is hereby ordered to surrender his/her driver's license to the Oklahoma Department of Public Safety, and to refrain from operating a motor vehicle in the State of Oklahoma.

- 7. The original of the form prescribed by the Department of Public Safety, entitled Noncompliance with an Order of Child Support Order to Revoke Driving Privilege, shall be signed by this Court and forwarded to the Department of Public Safety in compliance with 47 O.S. § 6-201.1. The designated copy of said form shall be sent by the Department of Human Services to the Plaintiff by depositing the same in the U.S. Mail, first class postage fully prepaid, addressed to the Defendant at his most recent address of record.
- 8. The Department of Human Services shall notify the appropriate licensing board(s) to revoke, deny, and/or terminate any occupational or professional license(s) held by the Defendant, or for which the Defendant has made application.
