**CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel., John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

**JURISDICTION**

1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code 36 O.S. §§ 101-7004 and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
2. Respondent Curtis Pletcher (“Pletcher”) is a licensed professional bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 199574.
3. Respondent Chauncey Summers (“Summers”) is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 40041039.

**FINDINGS**

1. As of this date, Summers has five outstanding Final Administrative Orders against

him with fines totaling Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$2,155.00) in the following cases.

2. 11-0780-DIS

- a. On September 8, 2011, the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) issued a Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to Be Heard, mailed certified mail, return receipt requested to both Summers and Pletcher in case 11-0780-DIS.
- b. Summers and Pletcher were each fined Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) as a result of the forfeited bail bond in Tulsa County case CM-2011-899.
- c. Summers received the Order on September 12, 2011. Pletcher received the Order on September 22, 2011.
- d. The Order became final on October 24, 2011, and payment of the fine was due.
- e. Pletcher paid the fine on October 25, 2011.
- f. On November 1, the Department sent a letter to Summers by certified mail, return receipt requested, informing him that the Conditional Order was final and that he was to remit payment to the Department by November 10, 2011 to avoid further administrative action. Summers received the letter on November 9, 2011.
- g. As of the date of this Conditional Order, Summers has not paid the fine in case 11-0780-DIS.

3. 11-0779-DIS

- a. On September 8, 2011, the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) issued a Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to Be Heard,

mailed certified mail, return receipt requested in case 11-0779-DIS.

- b. Summers and Pletcher were each fined Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) as a result of the forfeited bail bond in Tulsa County case CM-2011-574.
- c. Summers received the Order on September 12, 2011. Pletcher received the Order on September 22, 2011.
- d. The Order became final on October 24, 2011, and payment of the fine was due.
- e. Pletcher paid the fine on October 25, 2011.
- f. On November 1, the Department sent a letter to Summers by certified mail, return receipt requested, informing him that the Conditional Order was final and that he was to remit payment to the Department by November 10, 2011 to avoid further administrative action. Summers received the letter on November 9, 2011.
- g. As of the date of this Conditional Order, Summers has not paid the fine in case 11-0779-DIS.

4. 11-0909-DIS

- a. On September 8, 2011, the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) issued a Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to Be Heard, mailed certified mail, return receipt requested in case 11-0909-DIS.
- b. Summers and Pletcher were each fined One Thousand Fifty Dollars (\$1,050.00) as a result of the forfeited bail bond in Tulsa County case CF-2011-1595.
- c. Summers received the Order on September 20, 2011. Pletcher received the Order on September 22, 2011.
- d. The Order became final on October 24, 2011, and payment of the fine was due.

- e. Pletcher paid the fine on October 25, 2011.
  - f. On November 1, the Department sent a letter to Summers by certified mail, return receipt requested, informing him that the Conditional Order was final and that he was to remit payment to the Department by November 10, 2011 to avoid further administrative action. Summers received the letter on November 9, 2011.
  - g. As of the date of this Conditional Order, Summers has not paid the fine in case 11-0909-DIS.
5. 11-1046-DIS
- a. On November 4, 2011, the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) issued a Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to Be Heard in case 11-1046-DIS.
  - b. Summers and Pletcher were each fined Three Hundred Thirty (\$330.00) as a result of the forfeited bail bond in Tulsa Municipal case 7057224.
  - c. Summers did not receive the Order but the Order was timely mailed to him. Pletcher received the Order on November 9, 2011.
  - d. The Order became final on December 10, 2011, and payment of the fine was due.
  - e. As of the date of this Conditional Order, Summers has not paid the fine in case 11-1046-DIS.
6. 11-1047-DIS
- a. On November 4, 2011, the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) issued a Conditional Administrative Order and Notice of Right to Be Heard in case 11-1047-DIS.

- b. Summers and Pletcher were each fined Two Hundred Seventy-Five (\$275.00) as a result of the forfeited bail bond in Tulsa Municipal case 319362.
- c. Summers did not receive the Order, but the Order was timely mailed to him. Pletcher received the Order on November 9, 2011.
- d. The Order became final on December 10, 2011, and payment of the fine was due.
- e. As of the date of this Conditional Order, Summers has not paid the fine in case 11-1046-DIS.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

The allegations are found to be true and correct, and Respondent Summers has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(7) for failing to comply with a five proper orders of the Commissioner.

### **ORDER**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Chauncey Summers' bail bondsman license (number 40041039) is suspended.**

Respondent is further notified that he may request a hearing within 30 days of the receipt of this Order concerning this action, and upon such request, the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall conduct a hearing before an independent hearing examiner. A request for hearing shall be made in writing to Michael P. Copeland, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56<sup>th</sup> Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112 and state the basis for requesting the hearing.

**If Respondent does not request a hearing within the 30 days allotted, this Order shall become a FINAL ORDER on the 31<sup>st</sup> day following the receipt of the Order, and Chauncey Summers' bail bondsman license (number 40041039) shall be suspended, and the fines totaling Two Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$2,155.00) shall be due.**
