

forfeited. An Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued by the court on June 13, 2012, and filed in the case. A true and correct copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was mailed to Respondent with return receipt requested within thirty (30) days after the Order was filed.

3. Aguilar received a copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture on June 14, 2012.

4. The ninety-first (91st) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondent was Thursday, September 13, 2012. The Defendant was not returned to custody within ninety (90) days of receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture, nor was the face amount of the forfeited bond deposited with the court clerk within ninety-one (91) days.

5. Respondent paid the bond forfeiture late on September 18, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The allegations are found to be true and correct, and Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1332 by failing to return the Defendant within ninety (90) days or remit payment in the face amount of the bond forfeiture within ninety-one (91) days from receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture.

2. Under 59 O.S. § 1310(B), any person violating a provision of the Bail Bond Act may be subject to a civil penalty ranging from \$250 to \$2,500.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Roberta Ann Aguilar is FINED Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

Respondent is notified that she may request a hearing within 30 days of the receipt of this Order concerning this action and upon such request the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall conduct a hearing before an independent hearing examiner. A request for hearing shall be made in


writing to William G. "Buddy" Combs, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th Street, Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112, and **give an explanation of Respondent's actions described herein and any defenses thereto.**

If Respondent does not request a hearing within 30 days of receipt of this Order, this Order shall become a **FINAL ORDER** on the 31st day following the receipt of the Order, and the fine ordered herein shall be due.
