**CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.

2. Respondent Randell Shane Daniel (“Respondent”) is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 199637.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent submitted his January 2012 Cash report to the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“Department”) on March 21, 2012—35 days after the report was due on February 15, 2012.

2. Respondent submitted his March 2012 Cash report to the Department on April 17,

2012—1 day after the report was due on April 16, 2012.

3. Respondent submitted his June 2012 Cash report to the Department on July 17, 2012—1 day after the report was due on July 16, 2012.

4. Respondent submitted his September 2012 Cash report to the Department on October 19, 2012—4 days after the report was due on October 15, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(22) for failing to file a report as required by Section 1314.

2. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1314(B), which states that “monthly reports shall be submitted electronically to the Insurance Commissioner by the fifteenth day of each month.”

3. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), “any person violating any provision of Sections 1301 through 1340 of this title may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for each occurrence.”

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Randell Shane Daniel is FINED Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

Respondent is further notified that he may request a hearing within 30 days of the receipt of this Order concerning this action, and upon such request, the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall conduct a hearing before an independent hearing examiner. A request for hearing shall be made in writing to Buddy Combs, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW


56th St., Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112, and state the basis for requesting the hearing.

If Respondent does not request a hearing within the 30 days allotted, this Order shall become a FINAL ORDER on the 31st day following the receipt of the Order, and the fine ordered herein shall be due.
