# CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

### JURISDICTION

1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is

charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance

Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O.S. §§ 1301-1340.

2. Respondent Jerry Bryan Shed ("Shed") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of

Oklahoma holding license number 199996.

3. Respondent American Contractors Indemnity Company ("ACIC") is an insurance

company licensed to act as bail surety in the State of Oklahoma holding NAIC number 10216.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about October 31, 2012, an appearance bond was executed as follows:

Bondsman:	Jerry Bryan Shed

Bond Amount(s):	\$300	

2. On March 4, 2013, the Defendant failed to appear, and the bond was declared forfeited.

3. On March 11, 2013, an Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was issued by the court and filed in the case.

4. A true and correct copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was mailed to Respondents with return receipt requested within thirty (30) days after the forfeiture.

The mailing to Shed was returned to the Tulsa Municipal Court by USPS marked as
 "Return to Sender, No Such Number."

6. ACIC received a copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture on March 18, 2013.

7. The ninety-first (91<sup>st</sup>) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondents was Monday, June 17, 2013.

8. The Defendant was not returned to custody within 90 days, nor was the face amount of the forfeited bond deposited with the Court Clerk within 91 days, after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondents.

9. As July 26, 2013, the bond forfeiture has not be paid or set aside or the bond exonerated.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Respondents have violated 59 O.S. § 1332 by failing to return the Defendant within

ninety (90) days or remit payment in the face amount of the bond forfeiture within ninety-one (91) days from receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture.

2. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1332(D)(4)(a), when a surety company does not properly deposit with the court clerk the face amount of the forfeited bond, the Commissioner shall "cancel the license privilege and authorization of the insurer to do business within the State of Oklahoma and cancel the surety appointment of all surety bondsman agents of the insurer."

#### <u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that American Contractors Indemnity Company and Jerry Bryan Shed are <u>each</u> CENSURED.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the face amount of the bond forfeiture shall be deposited with the Tulsa Municipal Court Clerk within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order. Failure to do so shall result in the **CANCELLATION** of American Contractors Indemnity Company's license privilege and authorization to do business within the State of Oklahoma and the **CANCELLATION** of the surety appointment of all surety bondsman agents of American Contractors Indemnity Company.

Respondents are further notified that they may request a hearing within 30 days of the receipt of this Order concerning this action, and upon such request, the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall conduct a hearing before an independent hearing examiner. A request for hearing shall be made in writing to Buddy Combs, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56<sup>th</sup> Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112 and <u>give an explanation of Respondents' actions alleged</u> herein and any defenses thereto.

If Respondents do not request a hearing within the 30 days allotted, this Order shall

become a FINAL ORDER on the  $31^{st}$  day following the receipt of the Order.
