CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is 1. charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
- 2. Danny McSwain ("Respondent") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 100105872.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On October 14, 2013, Respondent submitted to the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("Department") his September 2013 Roche Surety & Casualty Company report.
- 2. Respondent submitted with the report an Electronic Funds Transfer ("EFT") of Three Dollars (\$3.00).
- 3. On October 23, 2013, the Oklahoma State Treasurer charged the EFT back to the Department as "Not Sufficient Funds."
- 4. On October 28, 2013, Department staff sent Respondent a letter by email and certified mail, with return receipt requested, informing Respondent of the charge back and requesting that the

funds be replaced and a service fee of \$25.00 be paid within five days of receipt of the letter.

5. On November 7, 2013, Respondent replaced the EFT and paid the service fee owed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(27) by uttering insufficient funds to the Commissioner.

<u>ORDER</u>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Danny McSwain is CENSURED.

Respondent is further notified that he may request a hearing within 30 days of the receipt of this Order concerning this action and upon such request the Oklahoma Insurance Department shall conduct a hearing before an independent hearing examiner. A request for hearing shall be made in writing to Buddy Combs, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112, and give an explanation of Respondent's actions described herein and any defenses thereto.

If Respondent fails to request a hearing within 30 days of receipt of this Order, this Order shall become a **FINAL ORDER** on the 31st day.
