# CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

#### **JURISDICTION**

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
- 2. Respondent Jon England ("England") is a licensed professional bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 199950.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about November 4, 2013, an appearance bond was executed as follows:

Defendant: Sheritah Lynnae Williams

Case Number(s): CF-2007-349

City/County: Canadian County Court Clerk

Surety: Jon England

Bondsman:

Jon England

Power Number(s):

NA

Bond Amount(s):

\$2500 and \$2000 = \$4500

2. On May 5, 2014, the Defendant failed to appear, and the bond was orally declared forfeited. An Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was filed by the court on May 13, 2014. A true and correct copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture was mailed to Respondent with return receipt requested within thirty (30) days after the Order's filing.

- 3. England received a copy of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture on May 14, 2014.
- 4. The ninetieth (90<sup>th</sup>) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondents was Sunday, October 12, 2014.
- 5. The ninety-first (91<sup>st</sup>) day after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondents was Monday, October 13, 2014.
- 6. As of the date of this Order, the bond forfeiture has not been paid or otherwise set aside or the bond exonerated.
- 7. The Defendant was not returned to custody within 90 days, nor was the face amount of the forfeited bond deposited with the Court Clerk within 91 days, after receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture by Respondent.
  - 8. The bond was reported.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The allegations are found to be true and correct, and Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1332 by failing to return the Defendant within ninety (90) days or remit payment in the face amount of the bond forfeiture within ninety-one (91) days from receipt of the Order and Judgment of Forfeiture.
  - 2. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), any bondsman or company violating a provision of the

Bail Bond Act, 59 O.S. §§ 1301-1340, may be subject to a fine of not less than \$250 but not more than \$2,500.

#### **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jon England is CENSURED and FINED Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the face amount of the bond forfeiture shall be deposited with the Canadian County Court Clerk (or the bond forfeiture otherwise set aside or the bond exonerated) within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order. Failure to do so shall result in the CANCELLATION of Jon England's license privilege and authorization to do business within the State of Oklahoma and CANCELLATION of the surety appointment of all surety bondsman agents of Jon England.

If Respondents do not request a hearing within the 30 days allotted, this Order shall become a FINAL ORDER on the 31<sup>st</sup> day following the receipt of the Order, and the fines ordered herein shall be due.
