ORDER OF LICENSE PROBATION

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his undersigned counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
- 2. David Dale Daugherty ("Respondent") is an applicant for renewal of a resident insurance producer license in the State of Oklahoma. His address of record is 15312 N. May Ave., Edmond, Oklahoma 73013.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code. 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent applied for renewal of a resident insurance producer license on or about February 17, 2015.
- 2. Question 1(B) in the license application form asks the following: "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?" Respondent answered the question "yes".
- 3. If the question is answered "yes" the applicant must provide a written statement explaining the circumstances of the incident; a copy of the charging document; and a copy of the official document demonstrating resolution of the charges or any final judgment.
- 4. Respondent complied with these requirements and provided information showing that he is currently charged with a criminal felony for one count of sexual battery in the State of Oklahoma (Oklahoma County, Case No. CF-2014-1191).
- 5. Respondent provided a written statement that the matter was disputed and still pending.
- 6. Pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(6), the Insurance Commissioner may revoke an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent complied with Insurance Code requirements by disclosing the current criminal charges against him. The Insurance Commissioner may place a licensee on probation pending the outcome of a criminal matter. 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) & (D).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that Respondent is granted a resident insurance producer license on a probationary status pending final resolution of his criminal case. This Order shall be reported as an administrative action. Upon resolution of the criminal case, Respondent is **ORDERED** to report the final outcome immediately to the Commissioner. If convicted of a felony, his license may thereafter be **REVOKED**.
