ORDER OF LICENSE PROBATION

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his undersigned counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
- 2. Sarah Renee Tubby ("Respondent") is an applicant for a resident insurance producer license in the State of Oklahoma. Her address of record is 1704 Cherry Ln., Del City, Oklahoma 73115.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code. 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On or about April 14, 2015, Respondent applied for a resident insurance producer license with the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID").
- 2. Question 1(B) in the license application form asks the following: "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?" Respondent answered the question "yes".
- 3. If the question is answered "yes" the applicant must provide a written statement explaining the circumstances of the incident; a copy of the charging document; and a copy of the official document demonstrating resolution of the charges or any final judgment.
- 4. Respondent complied with these requirements and provided information showing that she had previously plead guilty to two counts of concealing stolen property in the State of Oklahoma and had received a deferred sentence on both counts (Oklahoma County, Case No. CF-1999-5912).
 - 5. Respondent provided a written statement concerning the matter.
- 6. Pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(8), the Insurance Commissioner may revoke an insurance producer licensee for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent complied with Insurance Code requirements by disclosing the prior criminal charges against her. The Insurance Commissioner may place a licensee on probation for a violation of 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A).

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that Respondent is granted a resident insurance producer license on a probationary status for a period of two (2) years. At the time of Respondent's renewal of her producer license, her probationary status shall be reviewed by the OID and the probationary status may be removed at that time. This Order shall be reported as an administrative action. If Respondent commits a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, her license may thereafter be REVOKED.
