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ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF SUSPENSION INSTANTER

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
- 2. Respondent Eugene Phillips ("Respondent") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 40036559.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On August 14, 2014, a Conditional Administrative Order was issued fining Respondent \$250 for failing to timely file his June 2014 Safety National Casualty Corporation report, a violation of 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24). He later made payment but still owes \$50.00 for costs. (Exhibit "A")
- 2. On November 10, 2014, an Administrative Order was issued following a hearing fining Respondent \$250 for failing to timely file his July 2014 Safety National Casualty Corporation report, a violation of 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24). Respondent failed to pay the \$250 fine

and the \$150 costs of hearing. (Exhibit "B")

- 3. On November 10, 2014, an Administrative Order was issued following a hearing fining Respondent \$250 for failing to timely file his August 2014 Safety National Casualty Corporation report, a violation of 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24). Respondent failed to pay the \$250 fine and the \$150 costs of hearing. (Exhibit "C")
- 4. On June 26, 2015, a Conditional Administrative Order was issued fining Respondent \$250 for failing to timely file his January 2015, March 2015 and April 2015 Safety National Casualty Corporation reports in violation of 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24). Respondent failed to pay the \$250 fine. (Exhibit "D").
- 5. Respondent has also failed to timely file his May 2015 Safety National Casualty Corporation report, a violation of 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24).
- 6. The Insurance Commissioner hereby finds that the condition and actions of the Respondent are such that the public health, safety, and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24) by failing to timely file monthly reports with the Insurance Commissioner, as required by 59 O.S. § 1314(B) and OAC 365:25-5-36.
- 2. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(7) by failing to comply with proper orders of the Commissioner.
- 3. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(32) by failing to accept or claim a certified mailing from the Insurance Department, addressed to the bondsman's mailing address on file with the Insurance Department.

- 4. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(A), the Insurance Commissioner may suspend the license of a bondsman for any of the above-referenced violations.
- 5. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1311, the Commissioner may suspend the license of a bail bondsman pending a hearing, if he determines that the conduct of the bondsman "is such that it may be a detriment to the public."
- 6. Pursuant to 75 O.S. §§ 314(C)(2) and 314.1, the Insurance Commissioner is authorized to take administrative action against Respondent on a summary and emergency basis pending proceedings for revocation or other action against the license of Respondent if the Insurance Commissioner finds that the actions of the Respondent are such that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively requires emergency action, and incorporates a finding to that effect in his order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner that Respondent's bail bondsman license is hereby suspended instanter. Respondent is fined \$1,000 for his continuous violations of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act and blatant disregard for the attached Insurance Commissioner's orders.

This suspension instanter shall continue until Respondent submits to the Insurance Commissioner all outstanding monthly bondsman reports, all outstanding fines or fees owed and the \$1,000 fine. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent is hereby given notice of an opportunity to request a hearing within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt of this order to determine if there are any reasons why Respondent's bondsman license should not be subject to suspension. If Respondent does not request a hearing before the end of said thirty (30) day period, this order shall become a final order and said suspension shall continue in force until

lifted by order of the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

If Respondent requests, the proceedings shall be conducted within ten business days after receipt of the request and in accordance with the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O.S. §§ 1301 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 et seq.

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7301, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
- 2. Respondent Eugene Phillips ("Respondent") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 40036559.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent failed to file his June 2014 Safety National Casualty Corporation report with the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("Department"), which was due Tuesday, July 15, 2014.
- 2. On July 16, 2014, Department staff sent an email to Respondent regarding the failure to file the report.
- 3. On July 18, 2014, Department staff spoke with Respondent and advised him to file his report.



- 4. On July 28, 2014, Respondent called the Department and stated he would be filing the report by Tuesday, July 29, 2014.
 - 5. As of this date, the report has not been filed with the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24) for failing to file a report as required by Section 1314.
- 2. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1314(B), which states that "monthly reports shall be submitted electronically to the Insurance Commissioner by the fifteenth day of each month."
- 3. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), "any person violating any provision of Sections 1301 through 1340 of this title may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for each occurrence."

ORDER

- 4. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(7) by failing to comply with, or violation of any proper order, rule or regulation of the Commissioner.

5. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), "any person violating any provision of Sections 1301 through 1340 of this title may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for each occurrence."


