CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his attorney, Barron B. Brown, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. John Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
- 2. Respondent is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a resident insurance adjuster holding license number 0100183330. Her address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID") is 215 W. Lawton, Copan, Oklahoma 74022.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an initial license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Insurance Adjusters Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. § 6219, § 6220(A) and (B).

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

- 1. On or about February 19, 2014, Respondent applied for a resident insurance adjuster license with the OID. Respondent applied under the name "Kristal Waits." At the time of her application, Respondent failed to notify the OID Licensing Division of her previous alias, "Kristal Conley." On the application form, the first question asks the following: "Have you ever been convicted of a crime, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a crime?" Respondent answered "no" to this question. A copy of Respondent's application is attached as Petitioner's Exhibit A.
- 2. The application form defines "crime" to include "a misdemeanor, a felony or a military offense." "Convicted" is defined as "having been found guilty by verdict of a judge or jury, having entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere or no contest, or having been given probation, a suspended sentence, or a fine." The application states that individual applicants can only "exclude misdemeanor traffic citations and misdemeanor convictions or pending misdemeanor charges involving driving under the influence (DUI) or driving while intoxicated (DWI), driving without a license, reckless driving, or driving with a suspended or revoked license and juvenile offenses."
- 3. The OID, relying on the information submitted by Respondent in the license application, issued an adjuster license to Respondent.
- 4. On or about June 22, 2015, the OID discovered that Respondent had previously entered a plea of guilty to a criminal felony charge for arson in the first degree under her previous alias, Kristal Conley. Respondent received a deferred judgment for this charge on or about March 27, 2013 in the District Court of Washington County, State of Oklahoma (Case No.

CF-2011-262). A copy of Respondent's judgment and sentence court documentation is attached as Petitioner's Exhibit B.

5. On or about July 1, 2015, OID Anti-Fraud Investigator Rich Koch ("Koch") contacted Respondent by phone. In the course of that conversation, Respondent acknowledged that she was the same Kristal Conley referenced in the attached court documentation.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 6220(A)(1); material misrepresentation or fraud in obtaining an adjuster's license.
- 2. Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 6220(A)(5); conviction of or pleading guilty or nolo contendere to a felony pursuant to the laws of this state, any other state, the United States, or any foreign country.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner that Respondent is CENSURED and FINED FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for material misrepresentation or fraud in obtaining an adjuster's license. The \$500.00 fine is to be paid within thirty (30) days made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department. The \$500.00 civil fine shall be paid by money order or cashier's check. Failure to pay the civil fine or request a hearing within thirty (30) days may result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in

writing addressed to Barron Brown, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th St., Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order.

Any such hearing shall be conducted according to the procedures for contested cases under the Insurance Code and 75 O.S. § 250-323. If the Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order shall act as notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing, and the Allegations of Fact, Alleged Violations of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order shall be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.



The Court further advised the Defendant of his/her rights and procedure to appeal to the Court of Criminal Appeals of the State of Oklahoma, and of the necessary steps to be taken by him/her to perfect such appeal, and that if he or she desired to appeal and was unable to afford counsel and a transcript of the proceedings, that the same would be furnished by the State subject to reimbursement of the cost or representation in accordance with Sec. 1335.14 of Title 22
