FEES

Those individuals applying for <u>original licensure</u>, or those considered a "new applicant", must include two (2) duplicate sets of fingerprints on the appropriate Civil Applicant Cards which can be obtained from the Real Estate Appraiser Board upon request. In addition to the fee referenced below, you must also remit \$41.00 for payment of the OSBI/FBI background check.

Those individuals applying for <u>original licensure as a Trainee Appraiser</u> must include a \$300.00 credentialing fee with this application and provide an original REA Form 8, Report of Supervisory Relationship.

Those individuals applying for <u>original licensure by examination at a level other than Trainee Appraiser</u> must include a non-refundable application fee with this submission, as follows: Applicants for State Licensed Appraiser or State Certified Residential Appraiser must include a remittance in the amount of \$150.00. Those applying for State Certified General Appraiser must include a remittance in the amount of \$225.00.

Those individuals who have established a bona-fide residence in Oklahoma and are applying for <u>transfer</u> of their credential from another licensing jurisdiction to Oklahoma should include a \$340.00 remittance with this application.

Those applying for reinstatement of an Oklahoma real estate appraiser credential should contact the Board office for guidance.
