

3. On September 21, 2009 Board staff received correspondence from Mr. Yeager requesting a 90 day extension to complete the 15-hour National USPAP course. Mr. Yeager stated that the Oklahoma City Appraisal Institute course he was scheduled to take in September was rescheduled, by the Appraisal Institute, for November.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

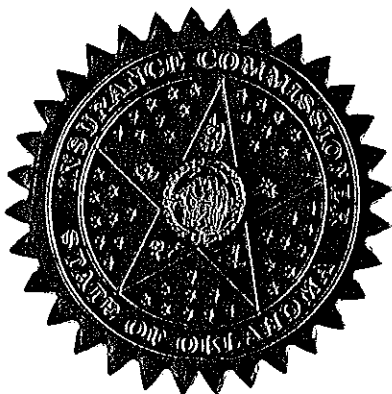
The Board has jurisdiction to hear this matter pursuant to Title 59 Sections 858-700 *et seq.* of the Oklahoma Statutes

FINAL ORDER


