BOARD'S DECISION ON NOTICE TO APPEAR AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

ON THE 8th day of October, 2010, the above numbered and entitled cause came on for hearing before the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board (the "Board"). The Board was represented by its counsel, Assistant Attorney General Bryan Neal. The Notice to Appear and Order to Show Cause was executed by the Board's Director, George R. Stirman III, and a copy is attached as Exhibit A. The Respondent, Roger H. Ford, appeared not, after having been mailed a copy of the Notice of Appear and Order to Show Cause by certified mail with return receipt requested pursuant to the Oklahoma Certified Real Estate Appraiser Act, 59 O.S. § 858-718, and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§250-323.

The Board, being fully advised in the matter, makes the following Order.

<u>JURISDICTION</u>

- That the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board has jurisdiction of this cause, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Certified Real Estate Appraiser Act, 59 O.S. § 858-700 et seq.
- 2. That the proceedings were conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Certified Real Estate Appraiser Act, 59 O.S. § 858-700 *et seq.*, and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S., § 301-323.
- 3. That Respondent Roger H. Ford is a certified residential real estate appraiser in the State of Oklahoma, holding credential number 10219CRA and was first credentialed as a real estate appraiser by the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board on November 13, 1991.

FINDINGS OF FACT

It is the finding of the Board that the following facts were proved by clear and convincing evidence:

- 1. That Respondent Roger H. Ford is a certified residential real estate appraiser in the State of Oklahoma, holding credential number 10219CRA and was first credentialed as a real estate appraiser by the Oklahoma Real Estate Appraiser Board on November 13, 1991.
- 2. That on July 23, 2010, Respondent Roger H. Ford entered a plea of guilty, and was found guilty by the District Court in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma of the crime of Lewd Molestation, committed January 29, 2009, in violation of 21 O.S. § 1123.
- 3. That on July 23, 2009, Respondent was sentenced by the District Court in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma to, *inter alia*, a term of twenty-five (25) years in the custody of the Department of Corrections, with the first five (5) years to be served in custody and the remaining twenty (20) years to be suspended under supervision of the Department of Corrections. This was evidenced by a certified copy of the Judgment and Sentencing Sheet issued by the Tulsa County Court Clerk.
- 4. That the felony of Lewd Molestation constitutes a felony that is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a person developing real estate appraisals and communicating real estate appraisals to others.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board adopts the following conclusions of law:

That Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 858-723(C)(4): "A conviction, including a conviction based on upon a plea of guilty or *nolo contendere*, of a felony which is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a person developing real estate appraisals and communicating real estate appraisals to others."

RECOMMENDED DISCIPLINE

The Board, having adopted the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth above, sets forth the following Final Order:

Respondent's real estate appraiser credential is REVOKED without the right to reapply.

THE BOARD WISHES TO ADVISE THE RESPONDENT THAT HE HAS THIRTY (30) DAYS TO APPEAL THIS ORDER WITH THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT COURT.

Now, this 23RD day of JULY, 2010 this matter comes on before the Court for sentencing and the defendant appears personally and by his or her Attorney of record, BECKY MURPHY, and the State of Oklahoma is represented by JULIE DOSS. The Court Reporter, JANA HARRINGTON, is present.

The defendant previously entered a plea of GUILTY and has been found guilty by the Court of the crime of LEWD MOLESTATION, 21 O.S. 1123; date of offense of felony, 1-29-2009.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the defendant is guilty of this offense and is sentenced to a term of TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS in the custody of DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS with the first FIVE (5) YEARS to be served in custody and the last TWENTY (20) YEARS to be suspended UNDER DOC SUPERVISION. DEFENDANT TO REGISTER AS SEX OFFENDER; COMPLETE SEX OFFENDER COUNSELING AS DIRECTED. If ordered by the Court, the rules and conditions, signed by the defendant acknowledging his or her understanding are incorporated as Exhibit A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that in addition to the preceding terms, and the general miscellaneous costs of this action the defendant is also sentenced to a fine in the amount of \$600; Victim's Compensation Assessment in the amount of \$150.
