CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his counsel, Sara A. Worten, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., including the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act, 36 O.S. §§ 1435.1 through 1435.41.
- 2. Respondent Kimberly Lynn Perra ("Respondent") is a non-resident insurance producer holding license number 40084696. Respondent's mailing address of record is 605 Eugene Street, Merrill, Wisconsin.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code. 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent applied for renewal of her non-resident insurance producer license on or about May 13, 2019, with the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID").
- 2. On the application form, question 2 asks the following: "[h]ave you been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding...which has not been previously reported to this insurance department?" Respondent answered "no" to this question.
- 3. A background check conducted by the OID Licensing Division showed that Respondent had administrative action taken against her producer license by the Wisconsin Commissioner of Insurance in OCI Legal File No. 18-C42845 with the final order issued on October 25, 2018.
 - 4. Respondent did not report the Wisconsin administrative action to OID.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(1) by providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application.
- 2. Respondent violated 36 O.S § 1435.18(A) by failing to report to the Insurance Commissioner an administrative action in another jurisdiction within 30 days of the final disposition of the matter.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner that Respondent is hereby CENSURED and FINED \$100.00 for violation of 36 O.S. §§ 1435.13(A)(1) and 1435.18(A). The \$100.00 fine is to be paid within 30 days made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department. The \$100.00 civil fine shall be paid by money order or cashier's check. Respondent's renewal application for non-resident insurance producer license may be granted

upon receipt of payment of the fine. Failure to pay the civil fine or request a hearing within 30 days will result in your license application being withdrawn.

Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above will become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing addressed to Sara A. Worten, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th Street, Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order.

Any such hearing shall be conducted according to the procedures for contested cases under the Insurance Code and 75 O.S. § 250-323. If the Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order shall act as notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing, and the Allegations of Fact, Alleged Violations of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order shall be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.


