CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel, Barron B. Brown, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and as such is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., including the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1341.
2. Marshall Lloyd Clayton ("Respondent") is a licensed surety bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 3000263039. Respondent also previously held a cash bail line of authority, which he requested to the Oklahoma Insurance Department Bail Bonds Division to be deleted effective June 21, 2019.
3. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), in addition to any potential denial, censure, suspension, or revocation, any person violating any provision of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) nor more than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for each occurrence of a violation.

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

1. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1314(B) and O.A.C. 365:25-5-36(a), a licensed bail bondsman must electronically submit to the Insurance Commissioner (the "Commissioner") monthly reports for each component of the license held (i.e. each line of authority) within fifteen (15) days after the end of each preceding month – even if no bonds were written under any particular component of the license during that month.

2. As of the date of filing of this *Order*, Respondent has failed to submit his June 2019 monthly cash report to the Commissioner on or before the date in which the report was due on July 15, 2019.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(24) by failing to timely file a monthly report as required by 59 O.S. § 1314(B).

ORDER

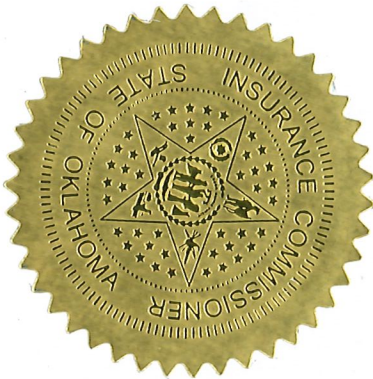
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent shall submit the monthly report referenced above and is **FINED Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)**. The monthly report and fine are to be submitted to the Oklahoma Insurance Department within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of this Order. Payment of the fine may be made by either cashier's check or money order. Failure to comply with a proper order of the Insurance Commissioner may result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of receipt of this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing addressed to

Barron B. Brown, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th St., Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order.

Any such hearing shall be conducted according to the procedures for contested cases under the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act (59 O.S. §§ 1301-1341) and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act (75 O.S. §§ 308a et seq.). If Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order shall act as notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing, and the Allegations of Fact, Alleged Violations of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order shall be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.


