CONDITIONAL ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel, Sara A. Worten, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY

- 1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7401, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1341.
- 2. Respondent James Panter ("Respondent") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 40144202. Respondent's mailing address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID") is 27 B Street S.E., Miami, Oklahoma 74354.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter raised in this dispute and may issue penalties pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310.

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

4. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1303, no person shall act in the capacity of a bail bondsman or perform any of the functions, duties or powers prescribed for bail bondsman under the provisions of 59 O.S. §§1301 et seq., unless that person is qualified and licensed as provided in

59 O.S. §§ 1301 et seq.

- 5. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1304 and OAC 365:25-5-35(d), each bail bondsman license issued will expire biennially at 12:00 midnight on the last day of the birth month of the bondsman. If the bondsman has not renewed the license by the expiration date, the bail bondsman is not authorized to continue acting as a bail bondsman.
- 6. Respondent was first licensed November 16, 2010. Respondent's date of birth is March 1, 1967. Accordingly, his license is set to expire every 2 years on March 31.
- 7. Respondent failed to renew his license by March 31, 2019, and his license expired.
- 8. OID notified Respondent his license was set to expire approximately 45 days prior to expiration.
- 9. Respondent's license was expired from April 1, 2019 to May 22, 2019. During that time he executed 11 bonds in the aggregate amount of \$13,176.00.
- 10. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(A), the Insurance Commissioner may deny, censure, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew any license issued under Sections 1301 through 1341 for any of the following causes:
 - 2. Violation of any laws of this state or any lawful rule, regulation, or order of the Commissioner relating to bail;
- 11. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), in addition to any denial, censure, suspension, or revocation of a license, any bondsman violating a provision of the Bail Bond Act, 59 O.S. §§ 1301-1341, may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$250.00 but not more than \$2,500.00 per violation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

12. Respondent violated 59 O.S. § 1310(A)(2) by acting as a bail bondsman in

executing 11 appearance bonds while he was not a licensed bail bondsman as required by 59 O.S. § 1303.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent is FINED \$300.00. This fine must be paid within 30 days of receipt of this Order. Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above will become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing addressed to Sara A. Worten, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th St., Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order.

Any such hearing will be conducted according to the procedures for contested cases under the Insurance Code and 75 O.S. § 250-323. If the Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order will act as notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing, and the Allegations of Fact, Alleged Violations of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order will be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.


