FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This matter is a denial proceeding under the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act. 36 O.S. §§ 1435.1 et seq. The Oklahoma Insurance Department (the “Department”) notified Respondent that his application for his individual insurance producer license was denied for having been convicted of a felony pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(6). Respondent requested a formal administrative hearing before an independent hearing examiner concerning the matter on March 18, 2020.

The Hearing was held before the undersigned Hearing Examiner on June 2, 2020. Petitioner appeared by counsel Sara A. Worten. Respondent appeared pro se. Witnesses were sworn and testified, exhibits were admitted and argument of counsel heard.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq, including the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act, 36 O.S. § 1435.1 et seq..

2. Respondent Jamale Antwyon Wilkes (“Respondent”) is an applicant for a resident insurance producer license in the State of Oklahoma. His address of record is 17 Mohican Circle, Shawnee, Oklahoma 74801.

3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act *36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D)*.

4. Petitioner afforded Respondent an opportunity for hearing by sending the *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause* by certified mail return receipt requested and by electronic mail on May 8, 2020 to Respondent. The *Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause*, filed on May 8, 2020, stated the matters asserted, and stated the time, place and nature of the hearing, cited legal authority and jurisdiction, and referred to particular sections of the statutes involved.

5. The Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to *36 O.S. § 319*, appointed an independent hearing examiner who sits as a quasi-judicial officer. The Insurance Commissioner appointed Stephen Mathis to hear the case as the independent hearing examiner.

6. The hearing was recorded electronically by an employee of the Oklahoma Insurance Department. Neither party requested a full stenographic record of the proceedings.

7. The following exhibits were introduced and admitted:

- a. Exhibit 1 – Respondent’s resident insurance producer license application;
- b. Exhibit 2 – Judgement and Sentence;
- c. Exhibit 3 – Motion to Revoke;
- d. Exhibit 4 – Information;

e. Exhibit 5 – Respondent’s Statement of Explanation;

f. Exhibit 6 – Respondent’s Request for Hearing;

8. The following witnesses were sworn and testified under oath:

a. Courtney Khodabakhsh, Manager of Licensing Division.

b. Jamale Antwyon Wilkes, Respondent

10. Respondent applied electronically for a resident insurance producer license on or about March 9, 2020 with the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“OID”). On the application form, one of the questions asked the Respondent, “Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgement withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?” The Respondent answered “yes” to this question.

11. On or about the 22nd day of April 2004, Respondent entered a plea of guilty and was convicted of four (4) counts of Lewd Acts with a Child Under 16 in CF-2003-198 in the District Court of Pottawatomie County, State of Oklahoma.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent’s application for resident insurance producer license may be denied under *36 O.S. §1435.13(A)(6)* based on Respondent’s conviction in CF-2003-198 in the District Court of Pottawatomie County, State of Oklahoma.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Jamale Antwyon Wilkes’ resident insurance producer license application is DENIED.


