Dear Speaker Charles McCall and President Pro Tempore Greg Treat:

Pursuant to 59 OK Stat § 4000.1(L), each state licensing or state certification authority authorized to consider the criminal conviction of an applicant shall annually provide to the Legislature, and publish on its public website, the following:
