Oklahoma is a national leader on developing a regulatory framework for Pharmacy Benefit Managers and serves as vice-chair on the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) PBM Working Group. During the last year, the PBM division has resolved over 200,000 violations, issued over 25 administrative actions, entered into eight settlement/consent agreements, and returned almost \$700,000 in fee reimbursements to local Oklahoma independent pharmacies.
