# CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

**COMES NOW** the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel, Antuanya "Bo" DeBose, and alleges and states as follows:

## **JURISDICTION**

- 1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7401, and the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act, 59 O. S. §§ 1301-1340.
- 2. Respondent Allison Janean Nixon ("Respondent") is a licensed bail bondsman in the State of Oklahoma holding license number 3000537769. Respondent's address of record is PO Box 573, Bartlesville, Oklahoma 74005-0573.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter raised in this dispute and may issue penalties pursuant to 59 O.S. §§ 1310 and 1332.
- 4. Pursuant to 59 O.S. § 1310(B), in addition to any potential denial, censure, suspension, or revocation, any person violating any provision of the Oklahoma Bail Bond Act may be subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$2,500.00 for each occurrence.

- 5. If the Respondent requests a hearing in writing in this matter, pursuant to *OAC 365:1-7-1*, the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to 59 *O.S.* § 1311.1, will appoint an independent hearing examiner who shall sit as a quasi-judicial officer and preside over the hearing requested by Respondent.
- 6. The Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to *OAC 365:1-7-5*, upon written request reasonably made by a person affected by the hearing and at such person's expense, shall cause a full stenographic record of the proceedings to be made by a competent court reporter.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

- 7. Pursuant to 59 O.S. §1314(B) and OAC 365: 25-5-36(a), every licensed bondsman shall electronically submit monthly reports for each line of authority by the fifteenth day of each month.
- 8. Respondent failed to timely submit her February 2021 Crum & Forster Indemnity Company report to the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID"). The report was due no later than March 15, 2021. Respondent submitted this report March 21, 2021.
- 9. Respondent failed to timely submit her May 2021 Crum & Forster Indemnity Company report to the OID. The report was due no later than June 15, 2021. Respondent submitted this report June 24, 2021.
- 10. Respondent failed to timely submit her August 2021 Crum & Forster Indemnity Company report to the OID. The report was due no later than September 15, 2021. Respondent submitted this report September 16, 2021.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11. Respondent has violated 59 O.S. 1310(A)(24) by failing to timely file her February 2021, May 2021 and August 2021 Crum & Forster Indemnity Company report in accordance with 59

#### **ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent is CENSURED and FINED Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). The fine shall be paid within 30 days of the date of this Conditional Administrative Order and made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department located at 400 NE 50<sup>th</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. Failure to comply with a proper order of the Commissioner will result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Findings of Fact set forth above within 30 days of the date of this Conditional Order, the penalties set forth above will become a Final Order on the 31<sup>st</sup> day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing and addressed to Antuanya "Bo" DeBose, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 400 NE 50<sup>th</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the 30 days allotted. The proceedings on such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 through 324. If Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order will act as a notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order shall be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.
