FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Kim Holland, Insurance Commissioner,
by and through her attorney, Julie Delluomo, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. Kim Holland is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 *et seq.*

2. Respondent is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a resident insurance producer holding license number 40084889.

3. The Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and/or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each occurrence of a violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a resident insurance producer holding license number 40084889. Respondent's address of record with the Oklahoma Insurance Department is [REDACTED] Respondent also has an address located at [REDACTED]

2. The Oklahoma Insurance Department was notified that Respondent was in violation of a State of Oklahoma Department of Human Services Administrative Enforcement Order issued November 3, 2009 imposing child support obligations.

3. The Oklahoma Insurance Department received a copy of a State of Oklahoma Department of Human Services Administrative Order issued December 15, 2009 that ordered all licenses held by Respondent revoked due to her continuing noncompliance with the child support payment plan (Exhibit "A").

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A)(13) by failing to comply with an administrative or court order imposing a child support obligation.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that the **Administrative Order of Suspension Instante** entered in this matter on February 25, 2010 is a **FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**, that no hearing was requested and Respondent's license is hereby **REVOKED**.



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NOW on this 15th day of December, 2009 this matter comes on before me, the undersigned Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to a Notice of Intent to Revoke Obligor's License(s) filed herein. A hearing has been conducted in accordance with Titles 43, 56 and 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, federal statutes and regulations and the Rules and Regulations of the Office of Administrative Hearings: Child Support. Upon review of the matter, the Court FINDS:

1. That an Administrative Enforcement Order was entered on November 3, 2009 requiring the Defendant to pay \$76.04 on or before the 1st day of each month towards the judgment amount of \$4142.24 commencing the 3rd day of November, 2009. In addition to the judgment payment, the Defendant was ordered to continue paying current support of \$223.96 per month.
2. That all of Defendant's licenses as defined by 56 O.S. Sections 237.7 and 240 *et. seq.* were placed on probation. That said probation was conditioned upon full compliance with the payment plan ordered and failure to abide by the payment plan shall result in automatic revocation of any license held by the Defendant.
3. That the Defendant has failed to comply with the payment plan entered on November 3, 2009. More specifically, the Defendant should have paid \$300.00 for November 3, 2009 through November 30, 2009. The Defendant has paid \$0.00. Defendant is \$300.00 behind on the payment plan.
4. That due to Defendant's noncompliance with the payment plan, all license(s) held by the Defendant as defined by 56 O.S. Sections 237.7 and 240 *et. seq.* are hereby revoked.


