

16, 2010 and made a claim with his insurance company, Armed Forces Insurance Exchange. Dean complained that the settlement check he received from his insurer was not the same amount as the estimate the insurer had previously given him. Dean made repeated requests to adjuster Anita Burleson to review his settlement payment, stating that his deductible had been applied twice.

2. Thereafter, Dean complained to the Department that Burleson made a mistake. The Consumer Assistance Division sent a letter of inquiry to the insurer. Ellen Wyrick,, supervisor of property claims with Armed Forces Insurance Exchange, responded to the letter of inquiry. Ms. Wyrick explained that Anita Burleson had used the wrong settlement figures and applied the deductible twice. Thereafter, a supplemental check in the amount of \$1,960.00 was issued to Dean to reimburse him for the error in the settlement.

3. A routine review of the Department's records determined Burleson was not licensed as an adjuster in Oklahoma. A request was made to Wyrick to report the number of Oklahoma claims Burleson adjusted while unlicensed.

4. Wyrick responded that Burleson had adjusted seventeen Oklahoma claims in 2008; nineteen Oklahoma claims in 2009; and twenty-one Oklahoma claims in 2010; totaling fifty-six Oklahoma claims that were adjusted while unlicensed.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS OF LAW

Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 6220(A)(9) by adjusting losses or negotiating claim settlement arising pursuant to insurance contracts on behalf of an insurer without proper licensing.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner, subject to the following paragraph, that the Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 6220(A)(9) and therefore **Respondent is FINED in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$560.00) payable within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing of this Order. Such request for hearing, if desired, shall be made in writing, addressed to Julie Meaders, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, Post Office Box 53408, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73152-3408 and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the thirty (30) days allotted. The proceedings on any such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 et seq.
