**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his undersigned attorney, and alleges and states as follows:

**JURISDICTION AND AUTHORITY**

1. John Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 *et seq.*

2. Respondent is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a nonresident insurance producer holding license number 40164718. Respondent's address of record is [REDACTED]

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Oklahoma Insurance Department (the "Department") received information that Joshua McClain had moved to Skiatook, Oklahoma from Houston, Texas sometime before November 2012.

2. McClain has never informed the Department that he has moved from Texas to Oklahoma and he remains an Oklahoma nonresident producer with the following address of record with the

Department: 15502 Ripplewind Lane, Houston, Texas 77068.

3. *Licensees shall inform the Insurance Commissioner by any means acceptable to the Insurance Commissioner of a change of address within thirty (30) days of the change. Failure to timely inform the Insurance Commissioner of a change in legal name or address shall result in penalty pursuant to Section 1435.13. 36 O.S. § 1435.8(F).*

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. Respondent has violated 36 O.S. § 1435.8 by failing to inform the Insurance Commissioner of his change of address within thirty (30) days of the change.

2. Failure to timely inform the Insurance Commissioner of a change of address shall result in penalty pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13.

### **ORDER**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** by the Insurance Commissioner, subject to the following paragraph, that the Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 1435.8 and 36 O.S. § 1435.13 and therefore **Respondent is FINED in the amount of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) payable within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing.**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing of this Order. Such request for hearing, if desired, shall be made in writing, addressed to Julie Meaders, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 100 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112 and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the thirty (30) days allotted. The

proceedings on any such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 et seq.
