REFORE THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER OF THE

CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. John D. Doak, Insurance Commissioner, by and through his undersigned attorney and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- John D. Doak is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq.
- Brittani L. Hutchison is an Oklahoma adjuster employed at Gallagher Bassett in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Her adjuster license 40151345 lapsed on November 30, 2012 for failing to renew. Her address of record is
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner may censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an adjuster's license and or may levy a fine up to \$1,000.00 for each violation of the Oklahoma Insurance Code. 36 O. S. § 6219 and § 6220(A) and (B).

ALLEGATIONS OF FACT

- Respondent Brittani Hutchison submitted an application to reinstate her adjuster license on May 17, 2013. The application stated under Respondent's employment history that she has been an adjuster at Gallagher Bassett from November 2011 – May 2013.
- 2. Respondent declared under penalty of perjury that the statements made in the application were true and complete.
- 3. Oklahoma Insurance Department records reveal that Respondent was issued adjuster license 40151345 on November 30, 2010. The license became inactive on November 30, 2012 for failing to renew due to not meeting the continuing education requirement. She became compliant with the continuing education requirement on April 26, 2013.
 - 4. Respondent requested reinstatement of her license on May 17, 2013.
- Respondent was required to maintain an active license while employed as an adjuster with Gallagher Bassett between December 1, 2012 through May 2013.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent violated 36 O.S. § 6220 (A) (8) by acting or holding herself out as an adjuster in this state while unlicensed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner, subject to the following paragraph, that the Respondent violated 36 O.S. §§ 6220(A)(8) and as a result Respondent is FINED in the amount of TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00). Fine to be paid within thirty (30) days of receipt of this Order.

Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless the Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Allegations of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of mailing of this Order, this Order and the penalties set forth above shall become a Final Order on the thirty-first day following the date of mailing of this Order. Such request for hearing, if desired, shall be made in writing, addressed to Julie Meaders, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 3625 NW 56th Street, Suite 100, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112 and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the thirty (30) days allotted. The proceedings on any such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et. seq. and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 through et.seq.
