CONDITIONAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF RIGHT TO BE HEARD

COMES NOW the State of Oklahoma, ex rel. Glen Mulready, Insurance Commissioner, by and through counsel, Antuanya "Bo" DeBose, and alleges and states as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. Glen Mulready is the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oklahoma and, as such, is charged with the duty of administering and enforcing all provisions of the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101-7401, including the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act, 36 O.S. § 1435.1 et seq..
- 2. Albright Ins Agency Inc ("Respondent") holding license number 100103053, is licensed by the State of Oklahoma as a business entity acting as an insurance producer. Respondent's address of record is PO Box 1147, Ponca City, Oklahoma 74602.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter raised in this dispute and may issue penalties pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13(A) and (D).

- 4. Pursuant to 36 O.S. § 1435.13(D), in addition to or in lieu of any applicable denial, probation, censure, suspension or revocation of a license, a person may, after opportunity for hearing, be subject to a civil fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each occurrence. The penalty may be enforced in the same manner in which civil judgments may be enforced.
- 5. If Respondent requests a hearing in writing in this matter, pursuant to OAC 365:1-7-1, the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to 36 O.S. § 319, will appoint an independent hearing examiner who shall sit as a quasi-judicial officer and preside over the hearing requested by Respondent.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 6. On or about May 1, 2023, the Consumer Assistance Division of the Oklahoma Insurance Department ("OID") received a complaint from an insured. The complaint stated the insured called Respondent in June 2022 to add a new rental property to their policy. After initially speaking to Respondent, the insured called back several times to check the status of the policy change and did not receive a response. The file number for the complaint is 116054.
- 7. While investigating this complaint, OID discovered Respondent's business entity resident producer license expired 03/31/2021.
- 8. On May 18, 2023, OID emailed a letter to Respondent and requested a response within twenty (20) days of receipt. The letter was emailed to <a href="mailed-emailed-
- 9. On or about June 8, 2023, another letter was emailed to the Respondent and a response was requested within twenty (20) days of receipt. The letter was emailed to cody.smith@lia-ks.com.

- 10. As of the date of this Order, Respondent has failed to submit a response to the May 18, 2023 and June 8, 2023 request(s) from OID.
- 11. A copy of the aforementioned letters are attached as "Petitioner's Exhibit A" and "Petitioner's Exhibit B."
- 12. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1250.4(B), any person subject to the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, upon receipt of any inquiry from the Commissioner shall, within twenty (20) calendar days from the date of receipt of the inquiry, furnish the Commissioner with an adequate response to the inquiry. The Commissioner may, upon good cause shown and on a case-by-case basis, extend the time allowed for a response for up to seven (7) additional calendar days. Any inquiry or response subject to this subsection shall be delivered electronically.
- 13. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.13(A)(15), the Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act or may levy a civil or any combination of actions, for failing to respond to an inquiry from the Department as required by 36 O.S. §1250.4.
- 14. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.8(F), licensees shall inform by any means acceptable to the Insurance Commissioner of a change of legal name, address, or e-mail address within thirty (30) days of the change to permit the Insurance Commissioner to give proper notice to licensees. A change in legal name or address submitted more than thirty (30) days after the change must include an administrative fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Failure to provide acceptable notification of a change of legal name or address to the Insurance Commissioner within forty-five (45) days of the date the administrative fee is assessed shall result in penalties pursuant to Section 1435.13 of this title.

- 15. Pursuant to 36 O.S. 1435.4(A), it is a violation of the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act to sell, solicit, or negotiate insurance in this state for any class or classes of insurance unless the person is licensed for that line of authority in accordance with the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act.
- 16. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.13(C), the license of a business entity may be suspended, revoked or refused if the Insurance Commissioner finds, after opportunity for hearing, that an individual licensee's violation was known or should have been known by one or more of the partners, officers or managers acting on behalf of the partnership or corporation and the violation was neither reported to the Insurance Commissioner nor corrective action taken.
- 17. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.7(B), a business entity acting as an insurance producer is required to obtain an insurance producer license. Application shall be made using the Uniform Business Entity Application or an application approved by the Commissioner.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 18. Respondent has violated 36 O.S. §1250.4(B) by failing to furnish an adequate response to two (2) inquiry letters from the Commissioner within twenty (20) calendar days from the date of the inquiry.
- 19. Respondent has violated 36 O.S. §1435.4(A) and 36 O.S. §1435.13(A)(2) by negotiating insurance in this state while not being licensed for the appropriate line of authority in accordance with the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent is hereby CENSURED and FINED One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). The fine shall be paid within thirty (30) days of the date of this Conditional Administrative Order and made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department. The fine shall be sent to the Oklahoma Insurance Department located at 400 NE 50th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Failure to comply with a proper order of the Commissioner will result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Respondent shall provide a response to the Oklahoma Insurance Department letters referenced above. The response shall be submitted to the Oklahoma Insurance Department within thirty (30) days of the date of this Conditional Administrative Order. The fine shall be made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department and sent to the Oklahoma Insurance Department located at 400 NE 50th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Failure to comply with a proper order of the Commissioner will result in further administrative action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Insurance Commissioner that this Order is a Conditional Order. Unless Respondent requests a hearing with respect to the Findings of Fact set forth above within thirty (30) days of the date of this Conditional Order, the penalties set forth above will become a Final Order on the 31st day following the date of mailing this Order. A request for hearing should be in writing and addressed to Antuanya "Bo" DeBose, Oklahoma Insurance Department, Legal Division, 400 NE 50th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. The request for hearing must state the grounds for the request to set aside or modify the Order and must be served on the Oklahoma Insurance Department within the thirty

(30) days allotted. The proceedings on such requested hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Oklahoma Insurance Code, 36 O.S. §§ 101 et seq., and the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 through 324. If Respondent serves a timely request for hearing on the Oklahoma Insurance Department, this Conditional Order will act as a notice of the matters to be reviewed at the hearing and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and penalties imposed in this Conditional Order shall be considered withdrawn, pending final resolution at the hearing.
