

4. The Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to 36 O.S. § 319, will appoint an independent hearing examiner to sit as a quasi-judicial officer.
5. Informal disposition of this matter may be made by agreed settlement pursuant to 75 O.S. §309(E).

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

6. The Anti-Fraud Unit of the Oklahoma Insurance Department (“OID”) received a complaint from Farmers Insurance (“Farmers”) alleging the Respondent opened three (3) unauthorized policies. Additionally, the OID received two (2) additional complaints from consumers regarding the Respondent.
7. Farmers conducted an investigation after receiving a complaint from insured Jimmy Butler stating the Respondent opened a homeowner’s policy in his name without his permission. Farmers reviewed the Respondent’s book of business and determined two (2) additional unauthorized policies were opened by the Respondent. Farmers contacted the two insureds (Martin Browning and Kelly Kyle), who confirmed they did not request the policies, nor sign any policy documents.
8. Additionally, the Respondent provided falsified, altered and fabricated verification of insurance cards to insured Andre Phillips. Andre Phillips was led to believe he had insurance when he in fact, did not.
9. Farmers terminated the Respondent’s appointment effective January 10, 2022.
10. Pursuant to the provisions of 36 O.S. §1435.13 (A), the Insurance Commissioner may place on probation, censure, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew a license issued pursuant to the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act for:

- a. Providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application;
 - b. Using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere;
 - c. Forging another's name to an application for insurance or to any document related to an insurance transaction;
11. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.13(D), in addition to or in lieu of any applicable denial, probation, censure, suspension or revocation of a license, a person may, after opportunity for hearing, be subject to a civil fine of not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each occurrence. Said penalty may be enforced in the same manner in which civil judgments may be enforced.
12. Pursuant to 36 O.S. §1435.13(F), the Insurance Commissioner shall retain the authority to enforce the provisions of and impose any penalty or remedy authorized by the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act and this title against any person who is under investigation for or charged with a violation of the Oklahoma Producer Licensing Act or this title even if the person's license or registration has been surrendered or has lapsed by operation of law.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

13. The Respondent has violated 36 O.S. §1435.13(A)(8) by opening three (3) unauthorized policies. Additionally, the Respondent provided falsified, altered and fabricated verification of insurance cards to an insured.

14. The Respondent has violated 36 O.S. §1435.13(A)(10) by forging the name of at least three (3) insureds on applications or other documents related to insurance.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Insurance Commissioner and **AGREED** by Respondent Brent Earl Mayes that the Respondent's resident insurance producer license number 3000862944 is hereby **REVOKED**. The Respondent is also **FINED** in the amount of **One Thousand Dollars** (\$1,000.00). The fine shall be paid within ninety (90) days from the date of this Agreed Order and made payable to the Oklahoma Insurance Department, located at 400 NE 50th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Failure to comply with a proper order of the Commissioner will result in further administrative action.


